Children's Classes, Tuesdays, 5 and 12 August 2008:

\$10 fee for each class includes all supplies. Students 6 to 12 years of age.

Drawing with Keith Russell, 10:00 – 11:30 a.m.

Basic class provides a solid foundation for drawing techniques. Children draw from still-life and mini Plein Aire in the garden area of Summit Art Center.

3D Art with Keith Russell, 12:00 noon – 1:00 p.m.

Working 3D art form out of sculpy-type clay that can be baked at home. Create a cherished keepsake!

Painting with Keith Russell, 1:00 – 2:00 p.m. (class size limited to 8 students)

Learn the basics of painting in watercolor from still-life and mini Plein-Aire sessions.

Recommended Materials: Floor-type easel, A-Clip drawing board, Drawing pad up to 20 x 24". Charcoal sticks, pencil, conte crayon, pastels, pen and ink, watercolor, acrylics, oils all welcome.

Description: Model poses nude and for the entire session on a platform. Fast few minute poses and longer poses take place during the session.

Note: Class limited to adults 18 years of age and above.

Portraiture Drawing Studies with Charles Pierce, Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.

Fee: \$13.50 Members, \$15 Non-Members, Class Size limited to 6 to 8 students

Recommended Materials: Same as Life Studies (please see above)

Description: Portraiture model poses for 20 minutes with 10 minute breaks between poses. Pose time is approximately 120 minutes each session. During the breaks, questions are welcome and a critique is available upon request. This is a wonderful and open workshop for sharing and exchanging techniques.

Fee: \$15.00. Additional \$5 fee payable at class for those requiring supplies

Supplies: Pastels, pastel paper, easel, foam core board, painters tape, wet wipes, charcoal, rubber eraser, paper towels.

Description: Have fun learning how to paint with pastels! Students will learn about different techniques and pastels, about pastel paper, and more. This is a wonderful class for beginners!
